These volunteers help with moving and storing books. Kim replied that this should not be a problem as long as there is someone here at the library to coordinate this action. This usually takes place on a Saturday. Sharon will coordinate. Sharon Robinson reported on gift wrapping scheduled for December 17th. Setup will begin at 9:30am. Samantha Snyder will open the library. Sharon reported that she will stop at the pretzel place and donate them at the sale. Sharon also reported that she will make signs “Donations Accepted”. Sharon went on to report that there will be a wrapping raffle and that Terry VanLeer donated baskets. Tickets 3 for \$5.00.
