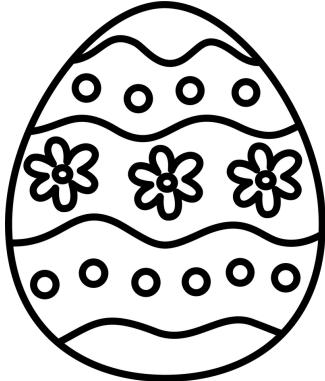

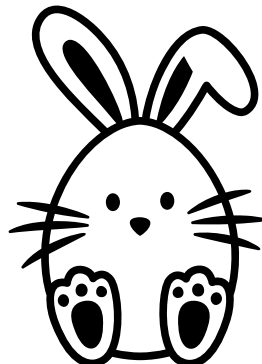
Get It Together! Homeschool Parents Meeting 4/13 at 6:30pm

Board Game Night for Adults 4/29 at 6:30pm

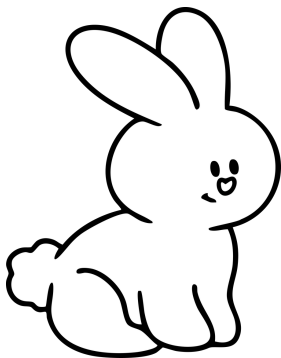

Right to Read 4/20 at 11:30am

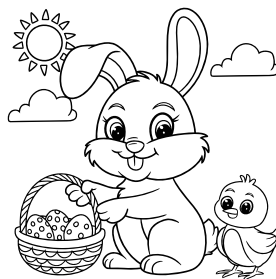
